

INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE: Installation and maintenance of said facilities on highway right-of-way shall conform to the following provisions:

Upon installation, maintenance, relocation or removal of said facilities, any right-of-way scars shall be removed and the disturbed areas restored to original condition, including the reseeded thereof where necessary. All pipes/hoses/lines will be placed outside the fence line or directly inside as close as possible to the fence with quick couplers at each crossing thru culverts in case of a storm event that requires to remove facility for emergency purposes and to prevent road damage due to high water flows.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS: Installation and maintenance of said facilities on the highway right-of-way shall be subject to the following terms and conditions:

- (A) Installation, maintenance, relocation, and removal of said facilities on the highway right-of-way shall be done in a manner satisfactory to and subject to supervision by the County Road Superintendent for the Dunn County Highway Department.
- (B) Dunn County shall not be liable for damage to said facilities resulting from construction, snow removal, grass mowing, reconstruction, expansion, alteration, maintenance, replacement and repair of the highway. Applicant shall hold the County harmless for injury to persons or damage to property resulting from the location of said facilities on highway right-of-way.
- (C) Applicant shall repair or replace highway structures and appurtenances, and any existing facilities located on, over or under the highway right-of-way, which may be damaged as a result of the installation and maintenance of said facilities on the highway right-of-way.
- (D) Applicant shall promptly remove said facilities from the highway right-of-way or shall relocate or adjust said facilities at its sole cost and expense when requested to do so by the County.
- (E) No temporary pipes/hoses/lines shall be permitted across any surface of county roadway. All facilities must be approved and installed running thru culverts crossing county roadways. All facilities crossing roadways must be flagged appropriately to insure visibility of presence in the road ditch above the grass.
- (F) Under no circumstance will temporary pipes/hoses/lines be allowed within 20ft of the road surface regardless of where the fence is installed.
- (G) Pumps, supplies, reels etc. will not be allowed in the right of ways.
- (H) During the winter months, temporary pipes/hoses/lines will not be allowed if the installation or removal causes obstructions of snow within or near the road.
- (I) Failure of applicant to follow all terms and conditions, as well as installation and maintenance requirements, will result in the immediate termination of this permit. This will require applicant to re-apply for a new permit with the corrections made and verified.

WHEREAS, the terms of Section 24-01-42 of the North Dakota Century Code, provide that the Board of County Commissioners/or its Director may grant such a permit.
